I find the current brewing fashion to be massive hops, high alcohol and calling your creation extreme or radical. Basically he proposes a lot of extract brewing and little all grain brewing. This would be a good book for a person who has made a few batches of homebrew. The typos include instructions to add both liquid and dry extract when the bill of materials does not differentiate to use either dry or liquid.
