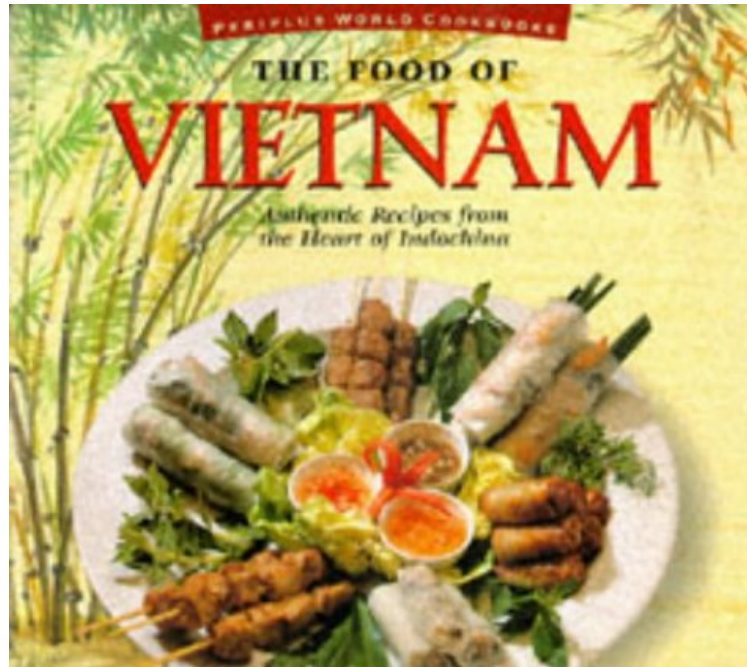


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Food of Vietnam (P) (Food of the World Cookbooks)
