It is so beautifully designed . . . lovely photographs, something inspiring to look at with every page you turn. The little hand-drawn graphics, the fonts and page layouts, even a gingerbread texture for the recipe pages---all show that this book was a labor of love.There are recipes for various types of gingerbread (quantities are given in weights), lots of different ways to use the dough, baking tips, and scaled-down patterns for several houses. Can't comment on the recipes as I haven't tried any yet, but I

will. Next year will definitely be a gingerbread Christmas at my house, though I probably won't wait that long to make the Apple Gingerbread Streusel Tart---it looks totally decadent.
