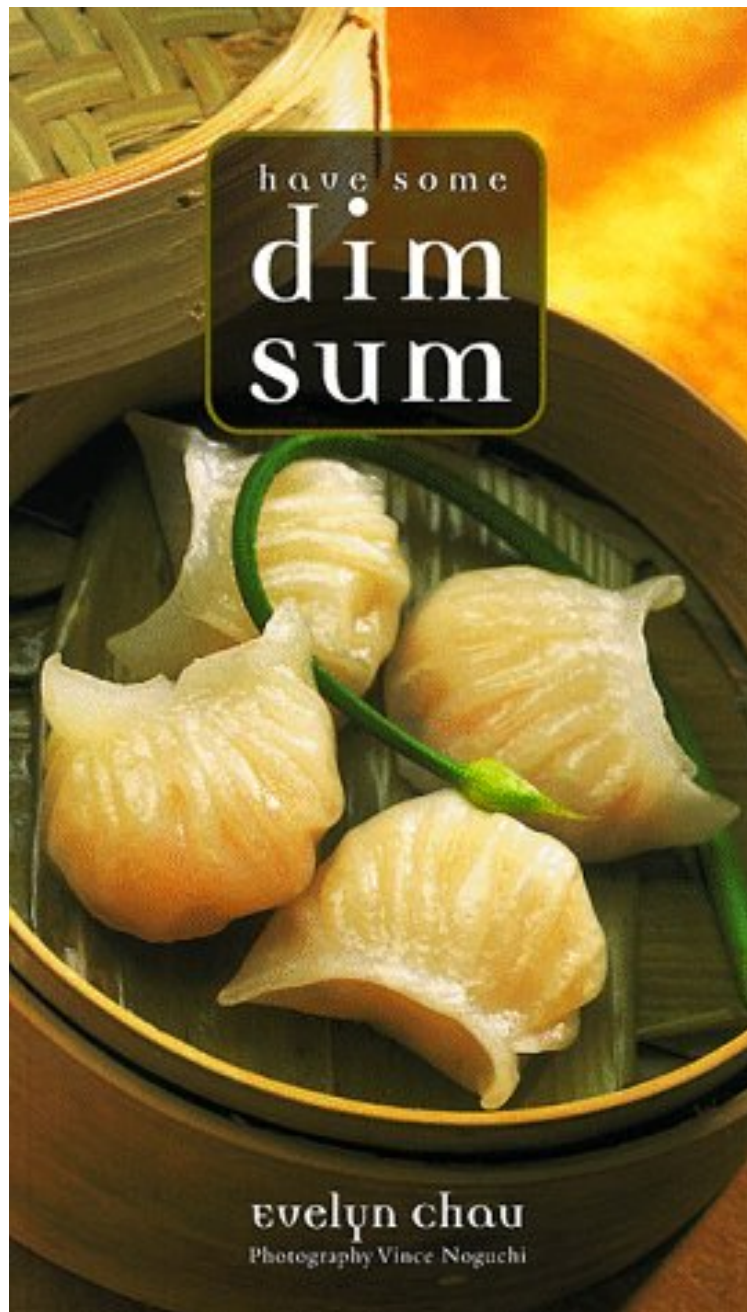

Basic ingredients for numerous popular types of Dim Sum are listed here along with detailed preparation instructions for selected dishes/baskets. Colour plates though limited, are tantalizing (and I suspect totally inedible).Don't try reading this at home when the least bit hungry (I tried), you will want to run out to the nearest chinese restaurant... To this end, each item's name comes with a pronunciation guide.Although I have been privileged to almost always have a chinese speaking person with me when ordering Dim Sum, I have noted that it is easy to order even when one cannot speak a word. In addition the Dim Sum featured in this book do represent a good cross section of the more delectable items (at least from a 'cultured'? westerner's perspective,) the majority of which are commonly available.P.S. Do try the oolong tea as recommended in the book if you do decide to 'Have Some Dim Sum'!
