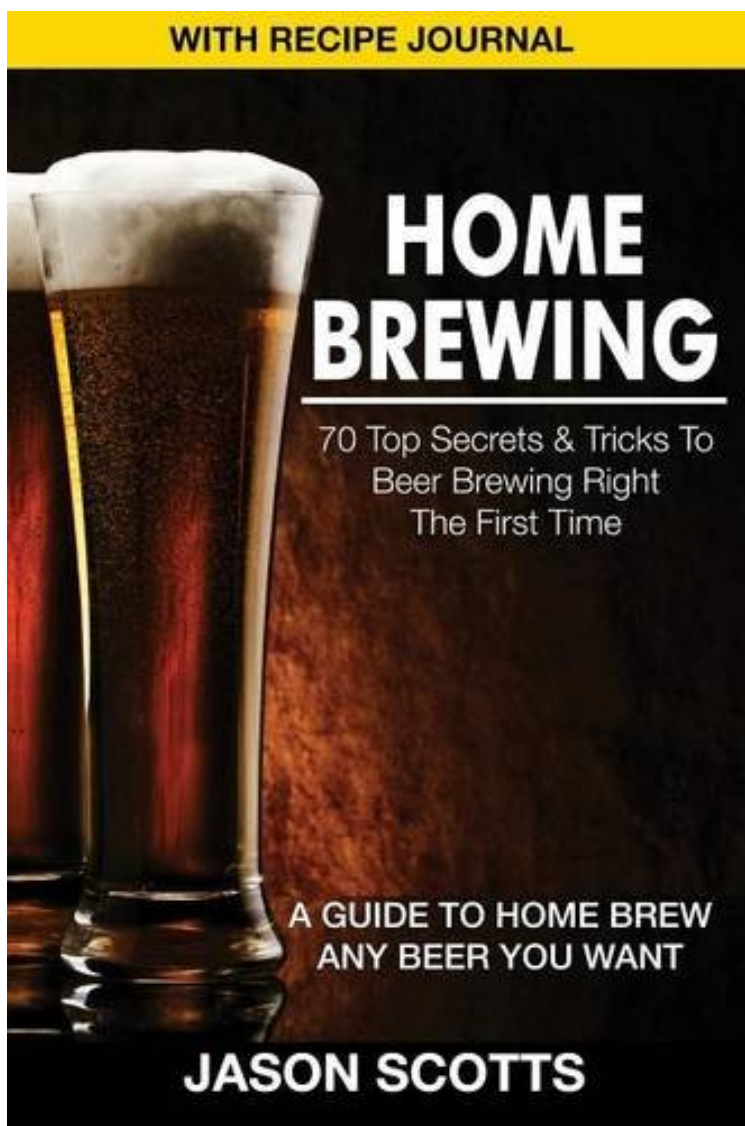

It is obviously written by someone who has never or almost never brewed. It gets basic terms wrong, has some directions that will cause a lot of problems, like telling folks to boil sugar (that would make caramel or a fire- he forgot to mention adding water to the sugar). It has strong statements that are flat out wrong and uses some very outdated procedures.I did have to smile a bit because it reminded me a lot of a number of home brew books I bought in the early 1980's that were also full of bad information. At least this book is not calling hops an optional ingredient.An experienced brewer will get PO'd by someone giving advice who obviously doesn't know what he is talking about and a beginner, if they follow directions is likely to get into trouble and decide it's all not worth it.If you are new to brewing or are interested in learning about brewing there are FAR BETTER places to learn.
