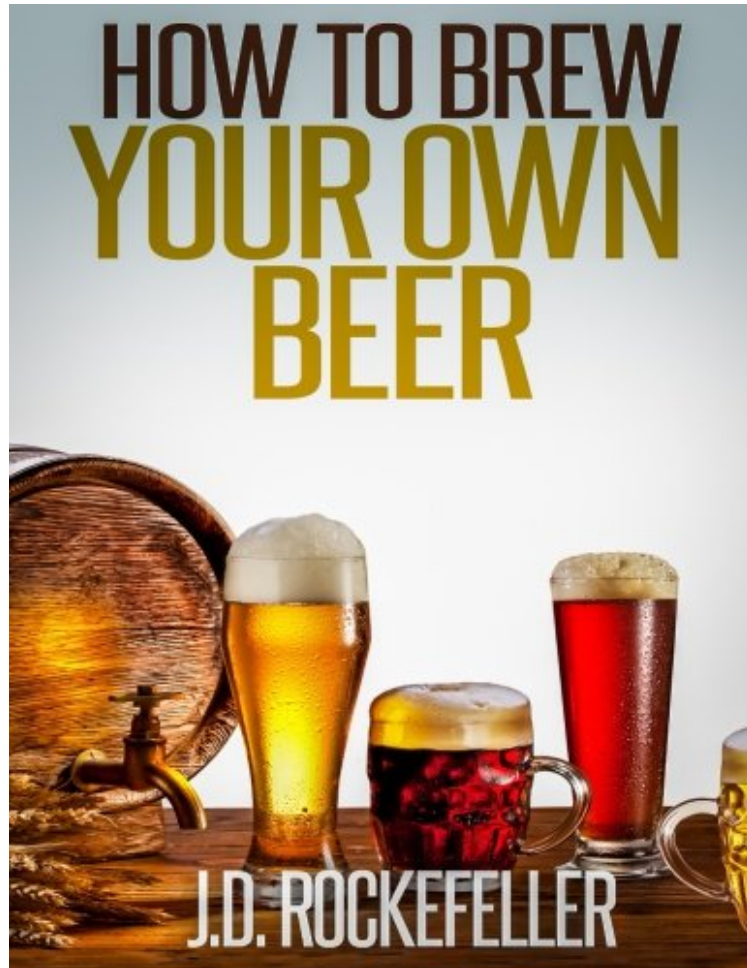

Although relatively brief, it contains everything you need to know to get started brewing your own beer. It begins with a brief history of beer, followed by a primer on the different styles of beer. It then gives an overview of the different ingredients found in beer, followed by short chapters describing each of these ingredients in more detail and how each of these ingredients affect the taste, smell, and body of the final product.The book then describes the equipment you will need to get started with your home brewing and the importance of cleaning and sanitizing this equipment. The author then takes you step by step through the brewing process. All of this is written in a nontechnical,

easy-to-understand fashion. This is followed by a chapter on storing your beer. The last chapter has recipes for the following beer styles: American pale ale, porter, and California common. While this book is primarily for those who are new to home brewing, even those who are experienced brewers can pick up important tips. I know I did.
