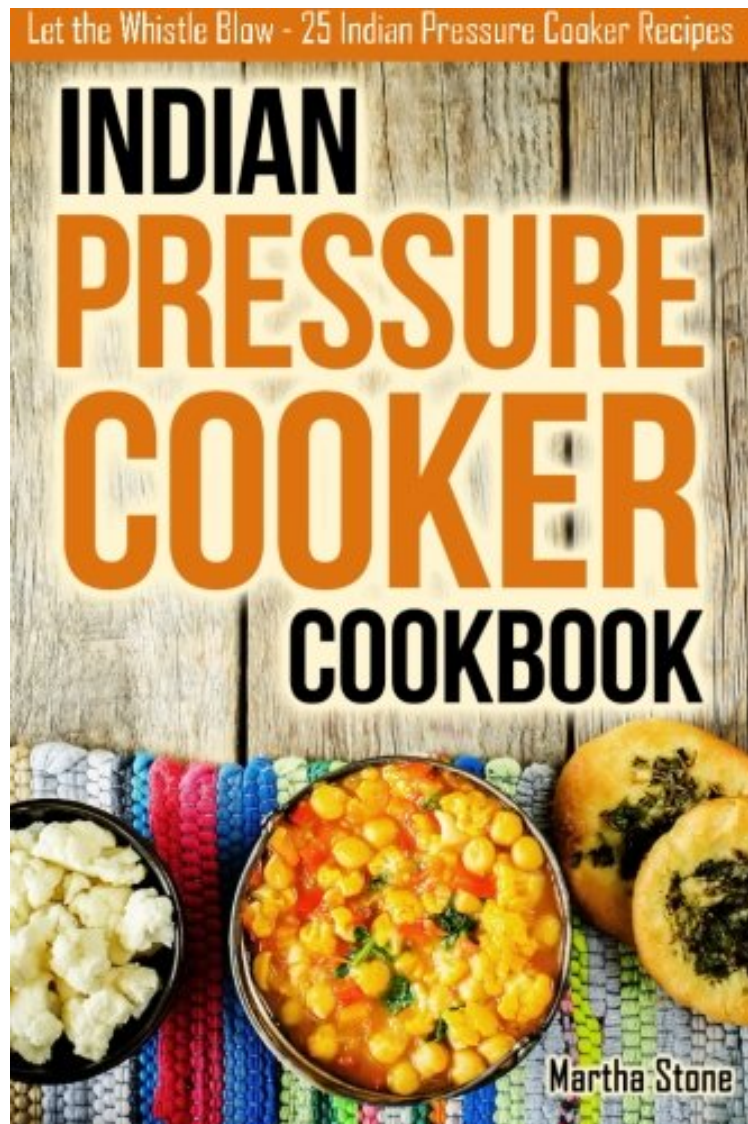

Get used to things like this: "Time Taken: 1/2 cups." Directions like this: "Mix and stir and let it cook in steam." or "Keep the sprouts in steam in a pressure cooker.". That's it, no time specified. Half the recipes do not mention steaming or pressure cooking at all. If that's not enough you have directions like this: "Ass some turmeric powder.." or "Soak the sprouts in oil for 6 hours in water.". Quantities like this: "Oil 2 spoons." If you are an experienced Indian cook you might be able to decipher this book by comparing it to other cookbooks but in the process you would be re-writing the book. The fundamental problem here is that every single recipe is basically missing fundamental directions.
