I bought my 1st edition of this book in India in early '70s use it constantly. I am known in my circle for my curries. My copy was falling to pieces I was more than a little surprised to find it available on-line. Unfortunately the new edition is printed in a smaller format than the original and the pages will not lie open - something rather to be desired in a recipe book. It loses mega stars for that. The new edition also leaves out most of the (interesting) acknowledgements at the beginning of the book (page 15). The one acknowledgement remaining credits the VA Museum in London for permission to use the 19th. C Indian painting for the cover illustration. Pity that the cover illustration on my edition is of a stylised pepper - or possibly okra, who can tell? - and not an Indian painting. This is just sloppy. One other complaint: The Book Depository charged me \$44 for sending it - by ordinary mail - to my postal address. I'd clicked on 'One Click order' and just didn't notice. I emailed who referred me to the Book Depository. I complained to them via what looked like the same form as that provided by . Of course I have received no reply.
