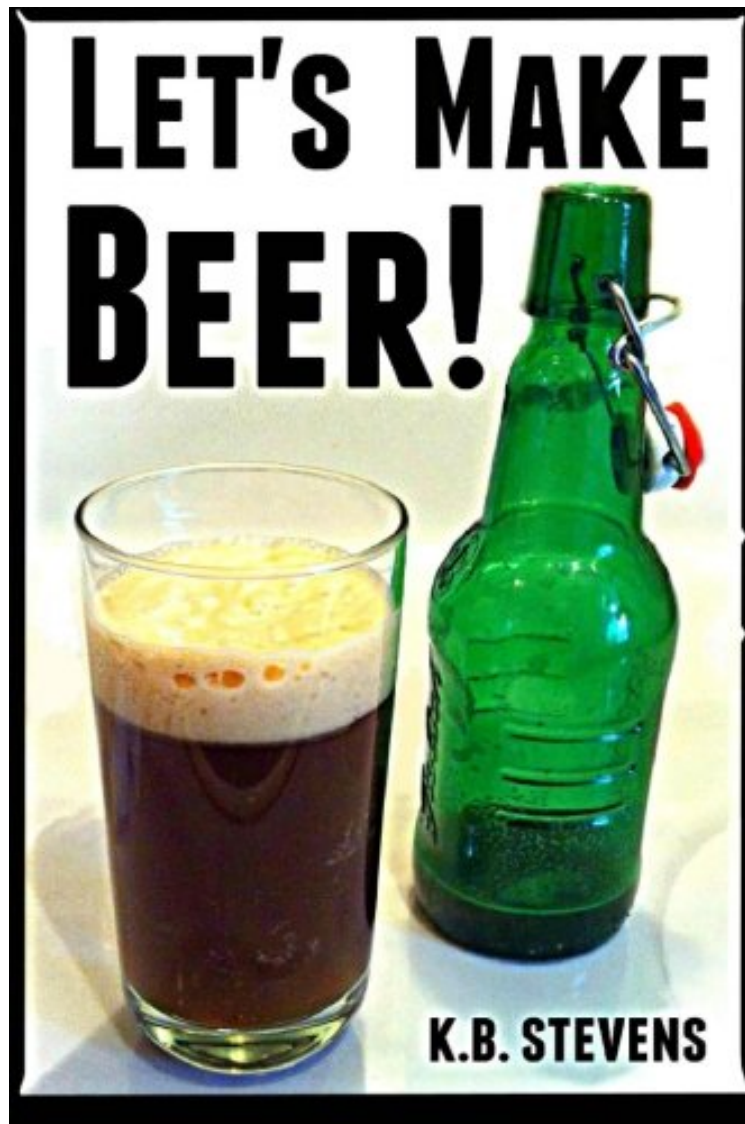

This publication suffers from the same issues that most self-published and Kindle-direct publications suffer from - a lack of basic editing. Simple proofreading or using the spell check function of whatever software package was used to type

this would really improve the work. The information is pretty good but suffers in its presentation because of grammar issues. On a much more positive note, the author has included pictures with the step by step instructions - these are invaluable. The pictures help the novice brewer know what right looks like, rather than just reading about it and hoping you're on the right track. Another positive - the recipes at the end of the book sound like they will be tasty if I decide to test them out.
