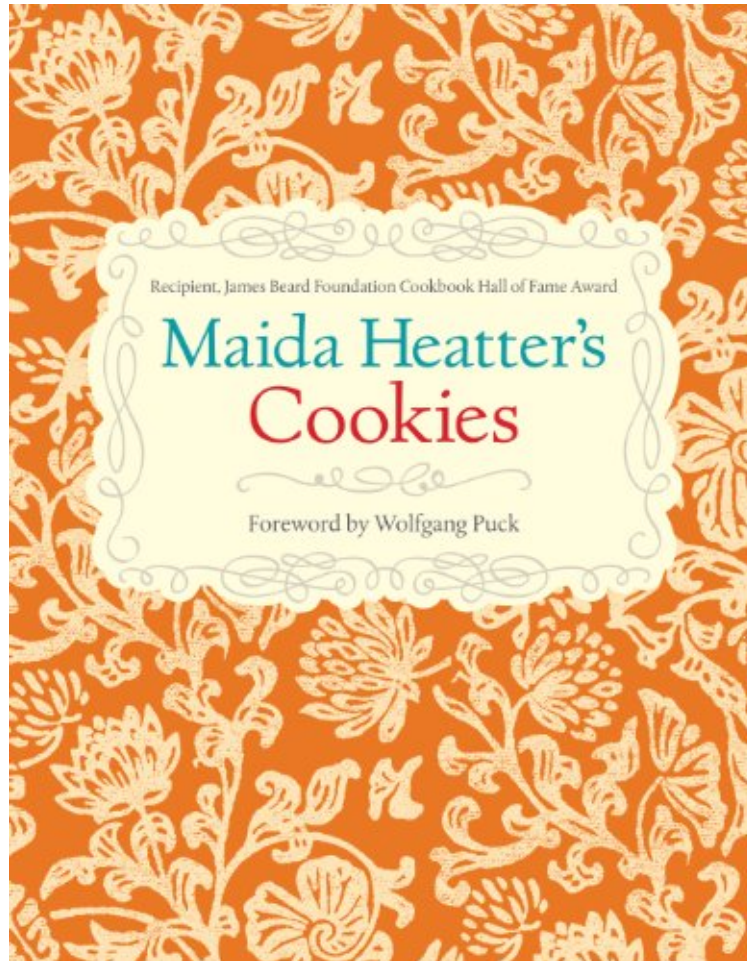

I've loved everything I've baked from the book, and appreciated the extra notes to tweak the recipe in additional ways. Nothing has been too complicated to make, as the directions and steps are well explained.My only real complaints about the

book are the ingredient lists and length of recipes. The ingredient lists run down the left side of each recipe, so your ingredient list may span two pages. This can make it easy to forget something if you aren't paying too close attention. The directions also span multiple pages, which requires you to flip pages to line up ingredients to steps.
