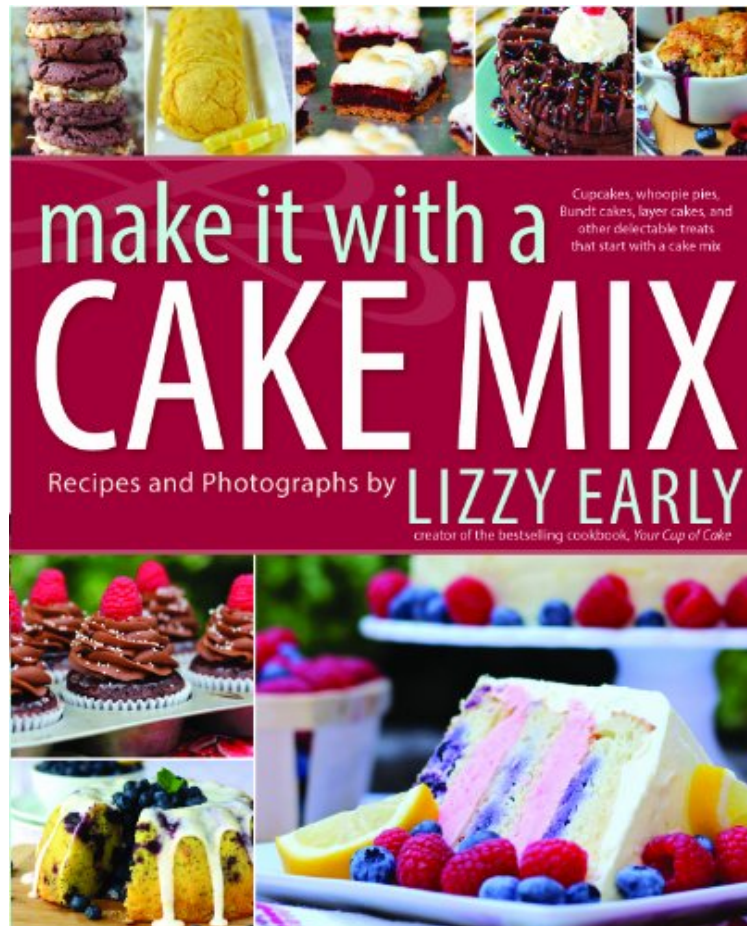

By Prisoner Of Hope Despite having over 1,000 cookbooks, I found myself reaching for Lizzy's "Your Cup of Cake" over and over again because every recipe I've made from it has been received with rave reviews, so I pre-ordered this book as soon as I heard about it on her blog. I'm mostly a "scratch" baker, but even though Lizzy starts with a cake mix, her recipes taste homemade. I never thought of adding a ganache topping to a cupcake, underneath the frosting, but this simple step (which she employs in

many of her recipes) transforms an otherwise ordinary cupcake into a gourmet treat. This second book is every bit (if not better) than the first; it includes recipes for Bundt cakes, whoopie pies, cupcakes, and cookies, and once again, every one I've made has been a huge hit. Don't let the fact that the recipes start with a cake mix stop you from ordering - the results are amazing! 5 of 5 people found the following review helpful. Semi-Homemade=Awesome Results! By J Gage I bought this recipe book because I don't mind cutting corners and making semi-homemade goodies. Some people rated this poor poorly because the recipes are not entirely made from scratch. If the readers paid attention, in the back of the book, Ms. Early included cake mix substitutions, so the purists would be happier. I, for one, couldn't be happier with using the mix. Let me continue to say that I am a good baker. I have tried all sorts of recipes, and these, by far, are some of the tastiest, most moist cupcakes and cakes I have ever had. So far I have made the Strawberry Red Velvet cupcake, Black Forest cupcakes, and Chocolate Zucchini Bundt cake. All three have met with rave reviews and requests for the recipe. The ingredients are easy to find and the directions couldn't be more simple. Ms. Early also has a website where she blogs a lot of these recipes on [www.yourcupofcake.com](http://www.yourcupofcake.com). The book is awesome because she includes pictures with each item, and it is a spiral bound book, making it easy to prop open on the counter.
